  - Produce or handle 80% of the items sold in our stores





## Natural Gas Supply


- In the past five years, shale reservoirs have revealed natural gas deposits that doubled previous estimated U.S. gas reserves

# What happens if the cost of fuel Doubles?

- Diesel in Gallons
- Today's retail \$4.00 (La Crosse, WI)
- Commodity \$3.00 (variable)
- Taxes, Margin, Etc. \$1.00 (fixed)
- Commodity (x2) \$6.00
- Taxes, Margin, Etc. \$1.00
- Total Cost of Diesel

\$7.00 / Gallon

- CNG in DGE
- Today's Retail
  \$1.80 (La Crosse, WI)
- Commodity \$0.65 (Variable)
- Taxes, Margin, Etc. \$1.15 (fixed)
- © Commodity (x2) \$1.30
- Taxes, Margin, Etc. \$1.15
- Total Cost of CNG

\$2.45 / DGE



- Cummins Westport 9L 250HP @ 850 lb. ft. Torque
- Allison MD3060 Transmission
- 100 Liquid Gallon LNG Tank / Approximately 50 Dge.

#### Class 8 Grocery/Zone Tractors

- Pulling Multi-temp refrigerated trailers.
- GCW 70-80K Diminishing Load
- Operate 2 Routes per Day Average Approximately 600 Miles Daily.
- Cummins Westport ISLG 9L 320HP @ 1000 lb. ft. Torque
- Allison MD3060 Transmission
- Fuel Storage: LNG Dual 119 Liquid Gallon / CNG Dual 45.5 Dge Tanks

#### Class 7 Fresh Delivery Trucks

- Currently operating 2 CNG and 1 LNG.
- Fit with Multi-temp refrigeration.
- Operate Daily Average Approximately 290 Miles/Day.
- GVW Up to 46K Diminishing Load
- Cummins Westport ISLG 9L 320HP @ 860 lb. ft. Torque
- Allison MD3060 Transmission
- Fuel Storage: LNG Dual 119 Liquid Gallon / CNG Dual 45,5 Dge Tanks
  - Diesel Currently Required for the Refrigeration Unit for now.



# **Bulk Transportation**

#### Petroleum and LNG Transport

- 9700 gallon MC406 Tank Trailers.
- GCW 50% Loaded @ 80K 50% Empty @ 25K
- Operate 24/7 Average Approximately 800 Miles Daily.
- Cummins Westport ISLG 9L 320HP @ 1000 lb. ft. Torque
- Allison MD3060 Transmission
- Fuel Storage: LNG Dual 119 Liquid Gallon / CNG Dual 45.5 Dge Tanks



# New LNG Technology





#### Spark Ignited vs. HPDI

- Spark
  - > 100% NG fuel supply
  - No EPA after treatment
  - > 85 90% efficiency
  - CNG and LNG

- HPDI
  - > 5% Diesel Pilot
  - > DPF, SCR, DEF, etc.
  - Compression ignitionperformance
  - > LNG only

## Power of Payback

- Spark ignited CNG
  - \$2.00 per DGE
  - > MPdge = 5.5
  - > \$4.00 Diesel
  - > MPG = 6.5
- O CNG CPM
  - > \$0.363
- Diesel CPM
  - > \$0.615
- NG advantage
  - > \$0.252

- HPDI LNG
  - > \$2.70 per DGE
  - > Mpdge = 6.5
  - > \$4.00 Diesel
  - $\rightarrow$  MPG = 6.5
- LNG CPM
  - > \$0.415
- Diesel CPM
  - > \$0,615
- NG advantage
  - > \$0.20
